



The lectures will be held in the campus of the "[Niccolò Cusano](https://www.niccolocusano.it/)" University, which is immersed in a 6 hectare green park, with classrooms, libraries, a gymnasium, and many other facilities.

The central Campus is easy to reach by underground and other public transport, from Rome Termini station and from the main airports of Fiumicino and Ciampino. Moreover, it is also easily reachable from the conference venue by public transport.

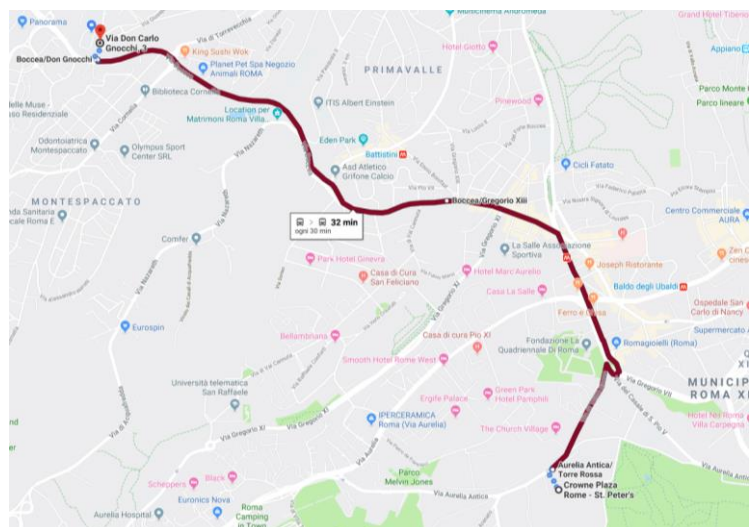

How to arrive at the School Venue from the Conference Venue

Directions:

1. Take Bus Line No. 889 (direction AGO/VAL CANNUTA) at the bus stop close to the hotel main gate (50 meters on the left going out from the hotel)
2. Get off after 6 stops at bus stop BOCCEA/GALEOTTI
3. Take one of the following Bus Lines:
 - No. 904 (direction BEDESCHI)
 - No. 905 (direction MALAGROTTA)
 - No. 993 (direction STAZIONE IPOGEO DEGLI OTTAVI).
4. Get off at bus stop BOCCEA/DON GNOCCHI.
5. Go to Via Don Carlo Gnocchi and reach the school venue on the left side by 50 meters walk.



How to arrive at the School Venue from the city center

Directions:

Rome is served by three metro lines (A, B and C) whose stations are shown below. The closest metro station to the School venue is "Battistini" (Metro A). The exchange stations are Termini (Metro A and B) and San Giovanni (Metro B and C).

1. Reach the metro station BATTISTINI
2. Take the Bus Line No.146 (direction MOMBASIGLIO)
3. Get off after 6 stops at the bus stop BOCCEA/DON GNOCCHI.
4. Go to Via Don Carlo Gnocchi and reach the school venue on the left side by 50 meters walk.



Public transportation: costs and useful links

The **Metrebus integrated travel tickets costs 1.50 €** and is valid for 100 minutes and for only one Metro ride.

The same ticket can be used for several bus rides as long as the 100 minutes expire.
